## **Background and Experience**

**Budapest Association for International Sports (BAIS)** is a volunteer-driven, non-profit organization dedicated to promoting physical activity, intercultural understanding, solidarity, environmental protection, and sustainability through sport-based non-formal education.

Our journey began in 2014 as an informal group of young people under the name *International Sport Association of Budapest (ISAB)*. By December 2017, we formalized our mission, becoming a registered non-profit association in Budapest, Hungary.

At BAIS, our primary goal is to foster grassroots sports participation and encourage healthy lifestyles among young people, regardless of their background or social status. Equally, we aim to unite individuals through a shared passion for sports and physical activity, captured in our motto: "Building bridges through sport."

Our target group includes international and Hungarian students, young professionals, and disadvantaged youth. Through free and accessible recreational activities, youth exchanges, training courses, and sports camps, we create learning opportunities that promote mutual understanding and friendship across cultures. Supported by 50 active members and initiative-takers, we help strengthen social bonds and mobility among diverse groups.

With a strong foundation in the Erasmus+ program since 2016, BAIS has organized and



partnered on over 50 projects across Erasmus+ Youth and Erasmus+ Sports initiatives. We've sent more than 500 young people to represent BAIS in various international projects, bringing back invaluable experiences, fresh ideas, and successful dissemination activities. In 2024 our association received accredited status by the Hungarian National Agency. This long-standing expertise makes us a trusted and dependable partner in fostering learning and collaboration through sports.

## **International Activities and Projects**

The Budapest Association for International Sports (BAIS) was founded by young individuals with extensive international experience and a shared passion for physical activity. Over the years, BAIS has developed strong international networks and gained significant expertise in managing international projects. Our mission is to harness the power of sports for social development, fostering social inclusion, solidarity, mutual understanding, and active citizenship through sport-based education.

Our members and volunteers have actively participated in a wide range of international training courses, seminars, study visits, and youth exchanges related to youth and sports. Many have also contributed to organizing international youth exchanges and training courses, building robust project management skills in the process. Since 2016, we have served as a sending organization for numerous Erasmus+ youth exchanges and training courses while successfully developing and implementing over 20 youth projects.

Since 2019, BAIS has been increasingly involved in Erasmus+ Sports projects, coordinating several impactful initiatives. These include small collaborative partnerships such as *Roma Inclusion through Sports in Europe (RISE)*, *Reinventing Sporting Traditions (ReSport)*, and *United through Urban Movement (UUM)*, as well as larger consortiums like *Green Education through Sports*. Additionally, we have hosted prominent awareness-raising sports events, including the *Mondiali Sports Festival* (2020) and the *FinishLine Semi-Marathon* (2023).

In recent years, our strategic focus has expanded to include promoting sustainability and environmental protection through sports, advocating for the inclusion of



disadvantaged groups (such as youth with physical disabilities), and raising awareness of mental and physical health across all age groups. To advance these goals, we have launched various initiatives, including the *Play for Sustainable Environment (P4SE)* capacity-building project and the *GREENTRACE* program.

Recognizing the growing importance of digitalization, BAIS has also initiated and led projects like *DFit* and *DigiPlay*, which explore the intersection of sports and digital innovation. These initiatives reflect our commitment to leveraging sports as a tool for positive societal change and addressing emerging challenges.

## **Key persons involved**

#### President – Bence Garamvölgyi, Ph.D.

Bence as the chair of the board oversees BAIS's international projects, bringing extensive expertise in project management and a strong background in both public and civil society organizations across Europe.
